1. What were the project goals and were they achieved?

The goal to provide fuel service to non-local pilots was achieved by installing automated equipment enabling local and transient pilots to self-fuel using a personal credit card to activate the pump and pay for purchases.

2. What were the activities undertaken and accomplishments through the completion of this grant?

An underground trench for electrical and phone line conduit was constructed. Then conduit for electrical and phone lines were laid and the phone line was activated. The automated card reader and support equipment was installed and went on-line as of July 7, 2005

3. What are the lasting benefits of the project?

Pilots will no longer bypass Garberville if fuel is needed. Instead they will be utilizing the area's various services, both business and recreational. Emergency Air service will also be able to operate out of the airport.

4. How will you continue work started by this project?

We will ensure that fuel is available to all pilots.
